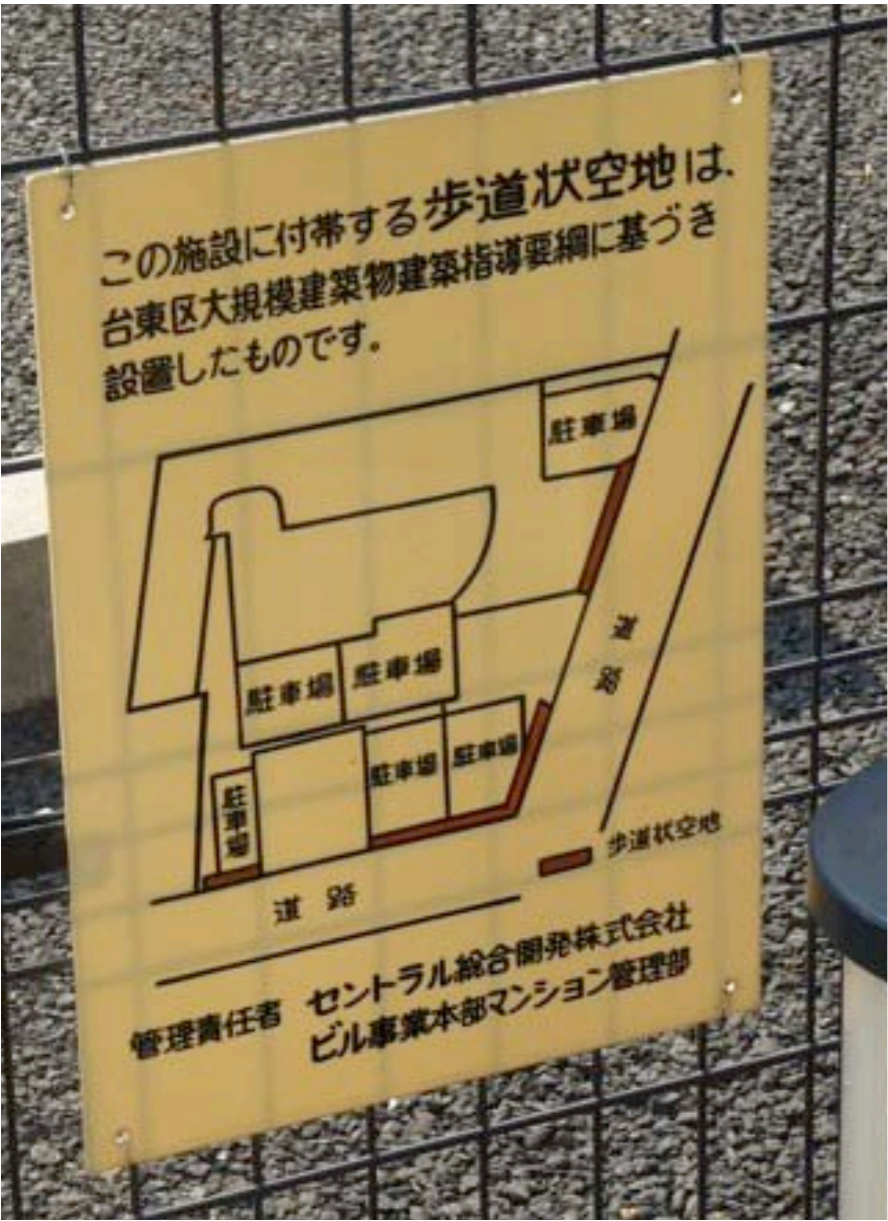

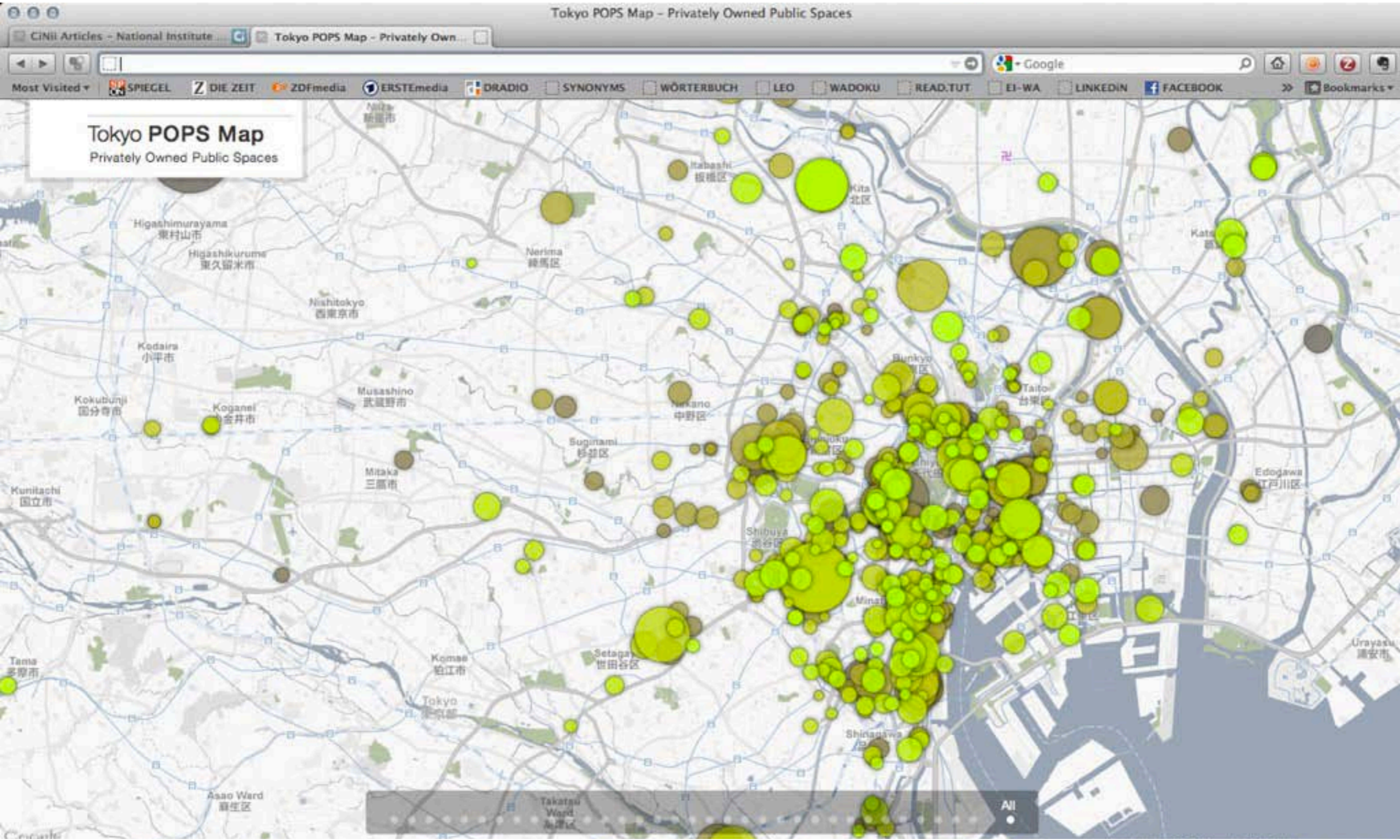
Building a Collaborative Platform, Building Awareness
